## NOMINATION FOR ELECTION of CATEGORY A / INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

### How the Election Works

CCAPP's election of members to the board of directors begins August 25, 2020, with an open nomination process. The elections will begin on October 9, 2020.

California has been divided into nine districts with approximately equal populations. This year, an election will be held for board members in Districts 6, 8 and 9.

### Nomination Process

There are three (3) ways in which a person may be nominated:

1. Each district must nominate at least one candidate;
2. Any CCAPP member living within the district may nominate a candidate to represent that district, and may even nominate him/herself;
3. The current board's election committee will nominate at least one additional candidate who lives in each of these three districts IF only one candidate has been nominated from within the district.

The only requirement for making a nomination is that the person making the nomination and the person being nominated must both be members of CCAPP in good standing. As per CCAPP bylaws, certified individuals who are not members cannot run for office.

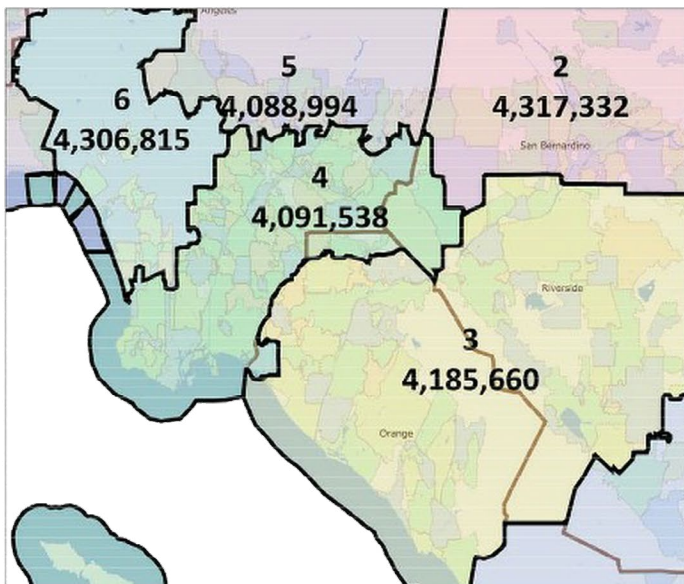
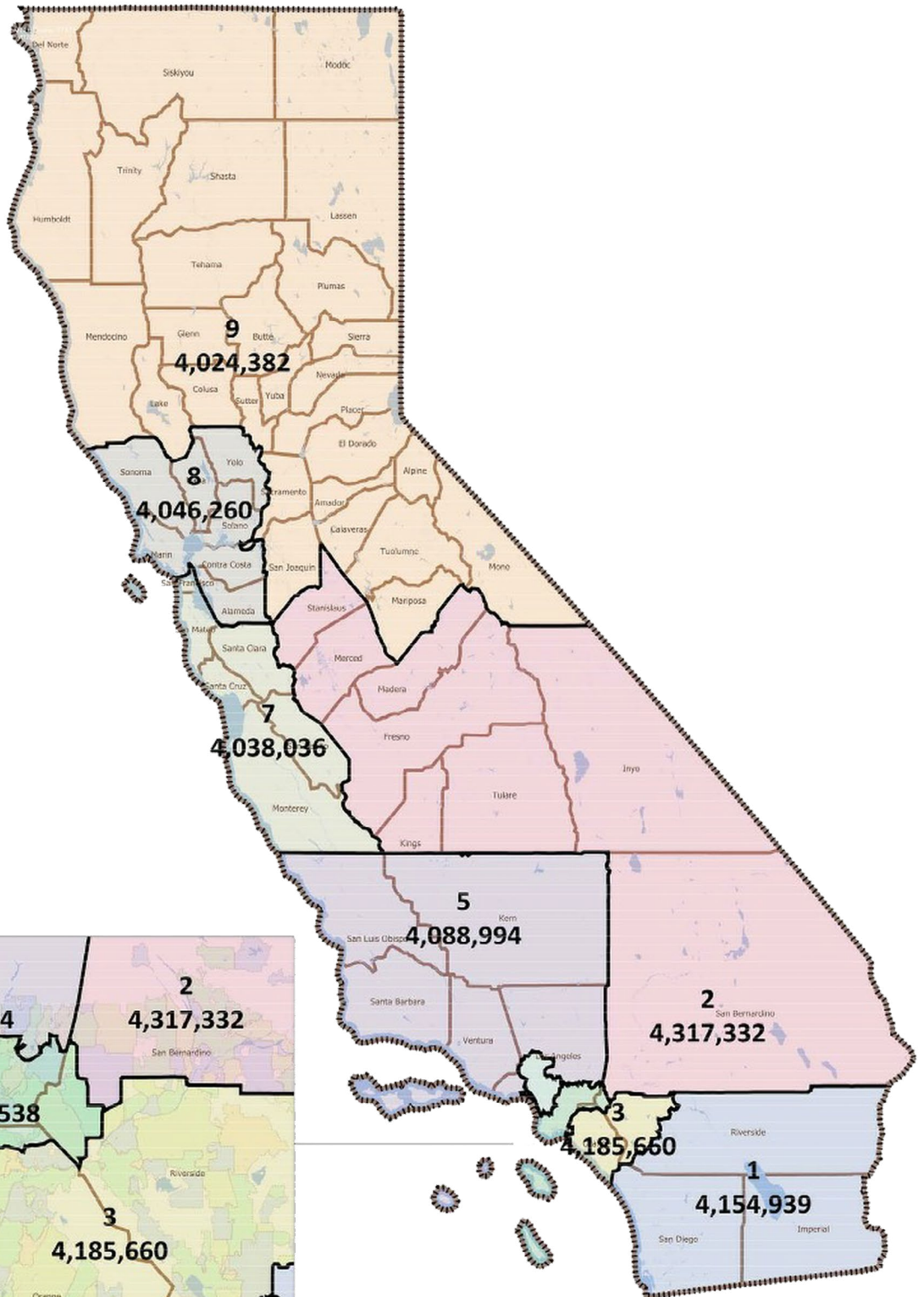
All nominations must be received in the CCAPP office no later than the close of business September 25, 2020. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Members residing in District 6, 8 or 9 are invited to participate in the nominating process this cycle. Members who do not reside in one of these districts cannot participate in the nomination process, however you WILL be able to vote for one candidate from each of these three districts pursuant to CCAPP's bylaws.
